

Lay of the Land

- Possum Point Power Plant Quantico
 - Potomac River and Quantico Creek
- Bremo Power Station Bremo Bluff
 - Upper James River
- Chesterfield Power Station Chester
 - Lower James River
- Chesapeake Energy Center Chesapeake
 - Elizabeth River



Coal Ash Campaign Goal

Passage of legislation in 2019 that provides a permanent solution to safely dispose of toxic coal ash through excavation and removal to a modern, lined landfill or recycling for safe beneficial reuse as concrete or other construction materials.

Legislative Details (...and the Devil)

- Excavation and removal of all coal ash at the 4 sites to a lined landfill, recycling of ash into concrete, or a "hybrid" approach.
- Implicitly or explicitly prohibit the use of cap-in-place at any of these sites for permanent disposal.
- Reference to State Corporation Commission process for Dominion to seek cost recovery for cleanup and disposal costs.
- If necessary, require coal ash cleanup to be completed in 15 years to comply with current federal and state regulations.

Current Status

- Legislative moratorium on DEQ permitting expires July 2019
- Dominion Recycling Report released on November 15, 2018
 - Multiple bidders proposed a combination of excavation/removal and recycling of all ash at the 4 sites in 15 years.
 - Cost estimate \$1.7 \$5.6 billion
 - Dominion also projects \$458 million costs through 2Q 2019 for ongoing coal ash storage costs at 4 sites, for which they will seek recovery.
 - Dominion also released groundwater monitoring data that confirms leakage of coal ash ponds at all sites
